Thank you for visiting Temple University on July 24, 2012 to discuss cooperation, including scholarship for DBMD students. DBMD students are eligible for scholarships each semester they are studying at Temple University based on the following schedule.

	GPA	Scholarship
Semester 1	3.0 + (GPA from home institution)	\$2,500 (all students entering DBMD program are eligible)
Semester 2, 3, 4	3.00 - 3.30	10% of tuition
	3.31 - 3.60	15% of tuition
	3.61 - 4.00	20% of tuition

Starting semester 2, DBMD students who meet the grade point average requirements are not required to apply for this scholarship. The Office of International Affairs automatically awards the scholarships to qualified students. For the past four years, majority of DBMD students have consistently qualified for the 15% – 20% range.

In addition, students in their second year are eligible to apply for graduate assistantships with their departments at Temple. Graduate assistantships provide tuition remission of 25%, 50%, 75%, or 100% and stipends; specific amounts depend on department funding and needs and students' qualifications.
